Separate sealed BIDS for the construction of the Phase IVB development of the Wise County Landfill - Blackwood Site, which consists of the construction of an access road, approximately 9.7 acres of composite liner system, a leachate management system, a gas management system, and associated items will be received by Mr. Shannon C. Scott, County Administrator at the Wise County Courthouse, 206 E. Main Street, Wise, Virginia, until 2:00 P.M. local prevailing time, on March 26, 2013.

No bids will be received or accepted after the above specified time for the opening of Bids. Bids submitted after the designated hour will be deemed invalid and returned unopened to the BIDDER.

Any BIDDER, NON-BIDDER, SUBCONTRACTOR, or SUPPLIER upon returning the CONTRACT DOCUMENTS within 30 days of Bid Opening and in good condition, will be refunded one-half of his deposit.

A Prebid Conference will be held on March 12, 2013 at 10:00 A.M. All interested parties are requested to meet the Engineer at the County Administrator's Office at the Wise County Courthouse, at that time.

Each BIDDER must be licensed as a Class A contractor in the State of Virginia.

Withdrawal of bids shall be according to procedure (i) of Section 11 54 of the Virginia Public Procurement Act and to the Code of Virginia (§ 2.2-4330). Any BIDDER must give notice in writing of his claim of right to withdraw his Bid within two business days after the conclusion of the Bid Opening Procedure. If a Bid is withdrawn, the next higher BIDDER shall be deemed to be the Low BIDDER. No Bid may be withdrawn unless said withdrawal is permitted by law.

MBE/WBE firms are encouraged to submit bids.

The OWNER reserves the right to reject any and all Bids if it appears in his best interest to do so.

In the event that the Total Base Bid from the lowest responsible BIDDER exceeds available funds, the OWNER may negotiate the Total Base Bid amount with the apparent low BIDDER to obtain a contract price within available funds, pursuant to Section 11-53 of the *Code of Virginia* (1950) as amended. Such negotiations with the apparent low BIDDER may include discussions in reducing the quantity, quality, or other cost saving mechanisms which are part of the Total Base Bid.
